
## WYCHAVON WAY WALKERS AND BRIDLEWAY USERS

## Track renewal between Hampton Lovett and Hartlebury

We wanted to let you know that we will be renewing the track near to St Marys and All Saints Church to Hartlebury Station. Please accept our apologies for the late notice of this letter.

The track and components are nearing the end of its design life and needs to be replaced. This is to make sure the track remains safe for passengers and trains. Due to the type of equipment we need to use this will, at times be noisy. Our teams will try to minimise disruption as much as possible, but we apologise in advance if you are disturbed during these works.

We will be working each night on the dates and times below when trains aren't operating, so our teams can work safely, but please be aware these dates may change:

Follow up works – testing and repacking the track stone	<ul> <li>Early hours on a Tuesday morning from Midnight to 9am on both the 7 July and 21 July.</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>Every Sunday morning (early hours) between midnight to 9am from 19 July to 23 August</li> </ul>
